1. During a scrimmage kick, kick-catching interference may occur in or beyond the neutral zone.
2. If a loose ball touches a game official, who is straddling the sideline, the ball is not out of bounds.
3. The snap is considered to be a backward pass and part of a loose-ball play.
4. A backward pass, in flight, may be batted in any direction by the passing team.
5. The down is ended when the kickers catch or recover a free kick anywhere.
6. Soft nonabrasive gloves may be worn if approved by the umpire.
7. If a free kick is repeated, the clock starts on the ready-for-play signal if it had been started on the original kick.
8. If R1 accidentally goes out of bounds during a scrimmage kick and then returns and catches the punt, it is a foul for illegal participation.
9. The spot where the run ends is where the runner loses player possession or where the ball becomes dead in his possession.
10. A pass thrown forward after change of possession during the down is an illegal forward pass
