1. What yard line has been established as the “Free Kick Line” for IWFL official play?
2. Does the IWFL have a “Two Minute Warning: established for it’s teams?
3. Is a player required to have one foot inbounds or two when completing a catch?
4. What is the official size ball of the IWFL?
5. During an Onside Kick, can a member of the Kicking team advance the ball if recovered?
